JH Yearly timeline and Grading System

- There are 3 trimesters which are 12 weeks long.
- You will have 6 classes on your schedule.
- Each class you will earn a grade of A, B, C D, F
- You will earn a citizenship mark of O for outstanding, S for Satisfactory and N for Needs Improvement and U for unsatisfactory

Grades and Grade Point Average-GPA

- Grades have a number value, which you need to know when you calculate the GPA
- Grade point average, or GPA is a number that tells how high you scored in your courses on average. Using a scale from 0.0 to 4.0, your GPA tracks your progress during your studies.
- GPA determine your eligibility for sports, leadership programs, activities such as dances, school spirit days and other activities at the secondary level.
- A's are worth 4 points
- B's are worth 3 points
- C's are worth 2 points
- D's are worth 1 point
- F's are worth 0 points

Calculating your G. P. A.

1. You will take each letter grade you earned and convert them in to the number value for all 6 classes.
2. Once you have a total, you will divide the total by 6 (for 6 classes) and that value will be your GPA.
3. Example: I have A in English, C in PE, C in Math, A in Science, C in History, D in Elective.
4. I will convert my grades to number values, with will be 15 in the example above.
5. I will divide 15 by 6 to calculate my Grade Point Average(GPA) with in this example will be 2.5

Promotion from 8th Grade in CVUSD
