COURSE DESCRIPTION

INTEGRATED MATH 2 IS THE SECOND COURSE OF A THREE COURSE SEQUENCE INCLUDING INTEGRATED MATH 1, INTEGRATED MATH 2, AND INTEGRATED MATH 3. THIS COURSE SATISFIES THE CALIFORNIA COMMON CORE STANDARDS FOR INTEGRATED MATH 2. FOR THE INTEGRATED MATH 2 COURSE, STUDENTS CONTINUE TO DEVELOP ALGEBRA AND GEOMETRY SKILLS THROUGH ENGAGING AND REAL LIFE APPLICATIONS.

STUDENTS WILL BUILD OFF OF THE STANDARDS THEY MASTERED IN INTEGRATED MATH 1 BUILDING ON GEOMETRY AND ALGEBRA SKILLS.

STUDENTS WILL DEMONSTRATE ABILITIES TO REASON LOGICALLY AND TO UNDERSTAND AND APPLY MATHEMATICAL PROCESSES AND CONCEPTS USING ALGEBRAIC OPERATIONS, GEOMETRY TOPICS WITH SPATIAL SENSE, DATA ANALYSIS, AND PROBABILITY. HONORS STUDENTS WILL RECEIVE MORE IN DEPTH PROBLEM SOLVING APPLICATIONS AND EXAMS REQUIRING A DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF THE CONTENT.

CLASSWORK: STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO ATTEND LIVE CLASSES, PARTICIPATE IN CLASS DISCUSSIONS AND ASK QUESTIONS. STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE NOTES DAILY AND ARE WORTH 5 PTS, COMPLETED. IN THE EVENT A STUDENT IS ABSENT, THE STUDENT WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR GETTING THE NOTES AND ANY WORK ASSIGNED UPON THEIR RETURN. WORK MISSED DUE TO AN UNEXCUSED ABSENCE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. ON OCCASION, STUDENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO COMPLETE ASSIGNMENTS IN CLASS, IN ADDITION TO OR IN LIEU OF NIGHTLY HOMEWORK ASSIGNMENTS. THESE ASSIGNMENTS ARE USED AS REINFORCEMENT FOR CONCEPTS LEARNED.

HOMEWORK: REVIEWING DAILY NOTES AND INDEPENDENT PRACTICE COMPLEMENT DAILY CLASS LESSONS AND ARE ESSENTIAL FOR CONTENT COMPREHENSION AND RETENTION. HOMEWORK MAY BE ASSIGNED MONDAY - THURSDAY. ASSIGNMENTS ARE WORTH 5 POINTS AND CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN ONLY IF THE ASSIGNMENT IS ON TIME AND COMPLETE. A COMPLETE ASSIGNMENT IS ONE IN WHICH ALL THE EXERCISES ARE NEATLY COMPLETED AND NECESSARY WORK SHOWN. MAKE UP HOMEWORK DUE TO AN EXCUSED ABSENCE MUST BE TURNED IN WITHIN 3 DAYS OF RETURNING FROM THE ABSENCE. LATE WORK FOR EACH UNIT MUST BE TURNED IN BY THE UNIT EXAM. MAKE UP OR LATE WORK TURNED IN AFTER SAID DEADLINE MAY NOT BE ACCEPTED. WORK MISSED DUE TO AN UNEXCUSED ABSENCE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. PLAGIARISM (COPYING ANOTHER STUDENT'S WORK OR FROM THE INTERNET) WILL RESULT IN NO CREDIT.

QUIZZES MAY BE GIVEN ANNOUNCED OR UNANNOUNCED IN EACH UNIT. TESTS WILL USUALLY BE GIVEN AT THE END OF EACH UNIT AND AT THE END OF THE SEMESTER. STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO MAKE UP QUIZZES OR TESTS DUE TO AN EXCUSED ABSENCE THE DAY THE STUDENT RETURNS FROM THE ABSENCE. THERE WILL BE NO MAKE-UP FOR TESTS OR QUIZZES MISSED AS A RESULT OF AN UNEXCUSED ABSENCE. PERFORMANCE TASKS MAY BE ASSIGNED THROUGHOUT THE SEMESTER AND WILL COUNT AS A SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENT.
