## Music Appreciation/Piano Lab Course Description Mrs. Anne Rutt - Instructor

Welcome to your foreign language class in music! Did you know that music is its own foreign language that only 2% of the world's population (that's about 140 million people) can read, write and play? Music Appreciation/Piano Lab is a 12 week elective class designed to teach reading (and when in-person also playing) music.

In Piano Lab/Music Appreciation students will learn about music notation (rhythm and pitch), music theory, and music history. If we get a chance to meet in person students will even get a chance to try out their new musical knowledge in the school's piano lab!

There will be music handouts, worksheets, graphs, music listening logs and test/quizzes. Tests will be written (or also playing piano, if we get to meet in-person during their trimester of this class). Students will also be expected to please neatly keep any handouts for reference in a section of their school binder that they designate just for their elective class, and have a working pencil with an eraser (we do not use pen in music). We use worksheets and handouts re-enforce learning. At home piano-practice is not required as we recognize that not everyone has access to a piano at home, but at home studying of material covered is expected, especially in preparation for tests.

With the skills you will gain in Music Appreciation/Piano Lab, we hope this will spark a love of music. As a 7th grader in Music Appreciation/Piano Lab, the skills your students gain will help prepare them if they choose to try band in 8th grade.
