

CVUSD District Dress and Grooming Standards

It is the intent of Edwin Rhodes Elementary School that Scholars be dressed and groomed in an appropriate manner that will not interfere with, or detract from, the school environment or disrupt the educational process.

DRESS CODE

Suitable and comfortable for normal school activities:

- Hats, beanies, or visors for outdoor use only
- Shoes and sandals with back straps
- Clothes and belts must be the appropriate size and length when worn

DRESS CODE


- Not permitted
 - Flip-flops
 - Midriffs, tube or strapless tops
 - Clothing which allows undergarments to be seen
 - Tattered clothes
 - Clothing containing emblems, printing, lettering or pictures pertaining to drugs, gangs, alcohol, smoking, sex, or profanity
 - Plain white t-shirts designed to be undergarments
 - Roller shoes/Heelies
 - Make-up



TRAFFIC RULES

Schaefer Avenue:

- Pull all the way forward
- Load/unload at curb
- Remain in your vehicle



San Antonio Avenue:

- Buses & official day care transport
- Kinder Scholars with decal
- Remain in your vehicle

Please use designated crosswalks to cross Schaefer, San Antonio, and the parking lot

SAFETY

- Closed campus Visitors must sign in at office to enter campus
 - Photo ID required
 - Connects to Meghan's Law database ONLY
- Regular family events allow you to connect with your child's class and other parents

ABSENCES

- Acceptable reasons for excused absences or tardies:
 - Personal illness
 - Personal medical, dental, optometric or chiropractic appointment (Doctor's note required)
 - Quarantine under the direction of a health officer
 - Funeral services for a member of the immediate family
 - Observance of religious holiday

TARDINESS

- School begins at 8:40 gates are locked
- Tardy students must enter through office
- Dismissal is at 3:20 (12:10 Tuesdays)
 - Students must be picked up within 25 minutes
- Traffic is not an excuse for tardiness please plan accordingly!

HOMEWORK
