

FIDM SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

FIDM awards a number of scholarships for new students, administered through recommendation from the Admissions Office.

Scholarships are offered based on a varying combination of qualities such as academic merit, financial need, industry experience, artistic achievement, and club affiliations.

Scholarship recipients are expected to be particularly strong and positive leaders once they are in attendance at FIDM, excelling academically and representing FIDM well within the community. Many scholarships are determined through review of Admissions application materials. Certain competitive scholarships have additional requirements.
