Classwork/Google Classroom - Walk Through

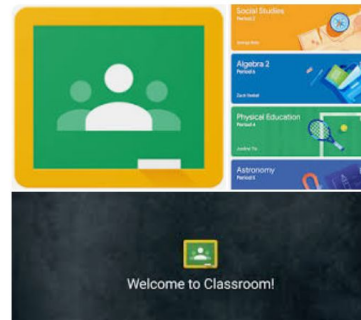
- We have 3 different ways students will complete and turn in work in science:

Absence/Late work
