

WHAT IS AVID?

- AVID stands of Advancement Via Individual Determination
- AVID is an in-school college readiness program for grades 9-12 that prepares students for college eligibility and success
- ->> It is a **global program** (currently in 16 other countries)



WHO IS AVID FOR?

- AVID is for ALL students, but targets students who are:
 - ➤ Highly motivated
 - ➤ 1st generation
 - Historically underserved
 - ➢ Or have special circumstances
- AVID is not an AT RISK program

Students must have GPA of 2.0 or above






