*Listed in order of Priority

- 12th grade students for 2015-2016 school year who need to make up an F in one of the courses offered or are deficient in credits.
- 11th grade students for the 2015-2016 school year who need to make up an F in one of the courses offered or are deficient in
- 12th and 11th grade students for the 2015-2016 school year who need to make up a D and/or F in one of the courses offered in order to meet the 2.0 GPA requirement for graduation.
- 10th and 9th grade students for the 2015-2016 school year who need to make up an F in one of the courses offered or are deficient in
- 10th and 9th grade students for the 2015-2016 school year who have an impacted schedule due to enrollment in an academy, leadership or other specialized program. Students must have 2 yrs of

Independent Study


Students work independently at home, outside the comprehensive high school setting for the majority of the day.

Two classes can be taken, daily, at student's home campus, if appropriate.

- * Student meets with instructor at the Alternative Education Center at least 1 time per week (scheduled).
- * Access to teacher and classroom at AEC whenever student attends.
- Student works on one subject at a time, packet format.
- Can earn up to 45 credits per semester.


Alternative Education Buena Vista High School


- Only Credit Recovery school in the district.
- Students earn credits with time in class.
- ✓ Homework not required.
- Can initiate extra work to earn additional high school credits.
- Can earn up to 45 credits per semester.
- ✓ Small campus/small class size



Buena Vista High School

- Application process/must be accepted.
- ✓ Attendance, discipline record, and current grades are considered for entrance.
- Must be 16 years old to attend.
- Limited orientations throughout the year.
- Ability to graduate early.





Virtual School

*Online, virtual classrooms, offered though Edgenuity, Gradpoint

*Taught by CVUSD teachers

*All class levels available

*Access 24/7

*Earn 30 credits per semester

Conclusion

- ♦ CVUSD has a number of options available for you and your child to take advantage of to help your child earn their high school diploma.
