Homework is targeted and purposeful, based on material already taught in class.

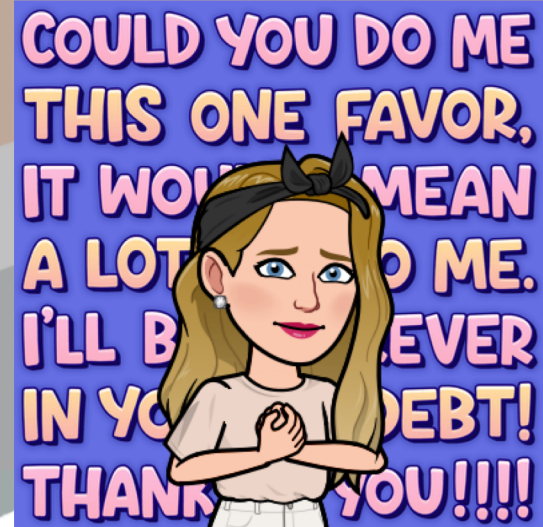
- Time given in class to complete assignments

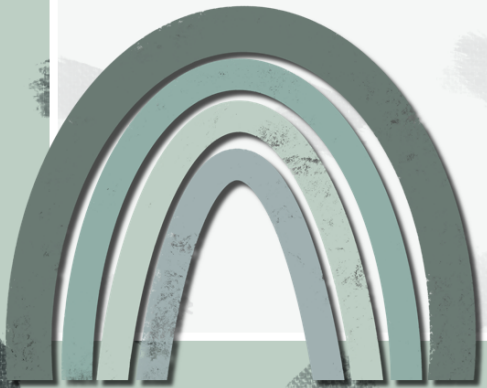

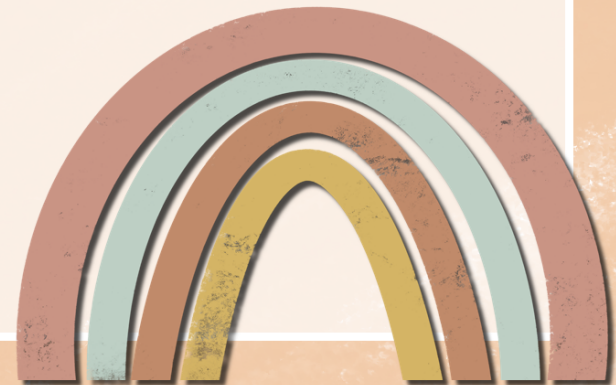

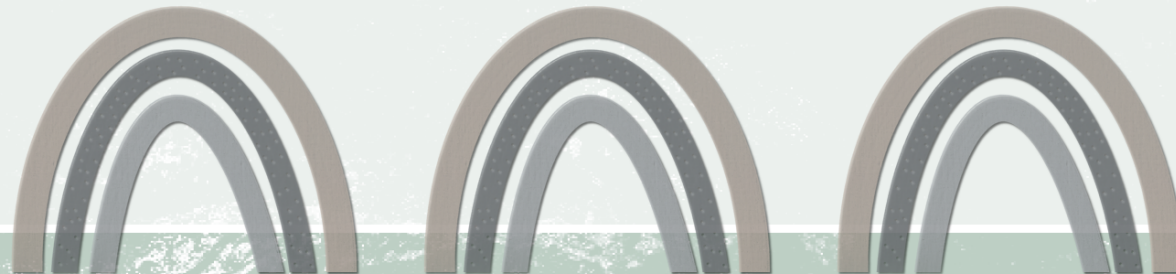
