

Woodcrest student expectations for learning and citizenship (behavior)

In class Wolverines will:

LEARNING

- Label all assignments with first and last name, date, and period in the upper right-hand corner.
- Keep organized notes and write the date the notes were taken.
- Record assignments in agenda daily!
- Must show work.
- Read and follow directions carefully.
- Participate in class discussions, ask questions and read aloud when asked.
- Speak and write using academic language and complete sentences.
- Write a topic sentence/thesis statement and support it with evidence.
- Read passages actively and with annotations (close reading).
- Follow all classroom rules.

In school (i.e. classroom, passing periods, lunch and before/after school) Wolverines will:

CITIZENSHIP

- Attend class daily; be responsible for make-up work if absent (ask your teachers or other responsible students).
- Keep organized backpack.
- Be seated, with all required materials, working on opening activity when the bell rings.
- Turn in homework at the beginning of the class period unless the teacher states otherwise.
- Participate in class discussions, ask questions, and read aloud (when asked).
- Communicate with fellow students at appropriate times.
- Ask for help when needed; give help when asked (but not during a test).
- Follow directions the first time they're given.
- Obey all school rules, including the dress code.
- Respect others and their property.
- Eating and drinking in designated areas only. (**Gum is NEVER allowed on campus**)
- Cell phones are to be used outside of the gates before or after school only.
