

CLASSROOM FAQs

What happens if a student breaks a classroom/school rule?

Students are expected to follow PRIDE expectations, which will be reviewed at the beginning of school. Failure to do so may result in the following: a verbal warning, detention, parent notification, parent and administration notification, or a student meeting with administration.
