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Welcome to the 2024-2025 school year, Cowboys! I am looking forward to a great year with all of you. Our class is Biology: The Living Earth, and we will be exploring and studying the living and nonliving parts of Earth's spheres, and how they interact on our incredible planet!

Materials: Our textbook is <u>Experience Biology The Living Earth</u>, by Miller & Levine. We have a class set of books to use. *Each day, please make sure you have the following materials:* your charged ChromeBook, power cord, lined paper and pencils.

Google Classroom: We will be using Google Classroom, and you will get an invitation sent to your student email to join our Google Classroom. Parents/Guardians will also receive an invitation to their email listed in Aeries. Assignments, materials and reminders will be posted in Google Classroom. You will usually turn assignments in during class, but I will let you know when you should be using Google Classroom to turn things in.

Grades: 90-100% A, 80-89% B, 70-79% C, 60-69% D, 59% and below: F. Your grades will be based 50% on assignments, and 50% on tests/projects/labs. Grades and missing assignments can always be checked by using the Aeries student or parent portal, or by emailing me. Artificial Intelligence (A.I.) should not be used for any assignment. Any assignment found to be created with A.I. will result in a score of 0.

Behavior Expectations: All Chino High School rules must be followed at all times. It is important for you to always respect yourselves, your classmates and your teachers. During labs, safety rules and directions must be followed at all times.

Cell Phones: Cell phones must be silenced and in students' backpacks during instructional time and class activities. Classroom staff will indicate any time when cell phones can be used.
