Class Syllabus: Guidelines and Expectations

Welcome to English Language Development!! In this ELD level course, students will be challenged to increase their English to develop language skills in academic content areas, as well as to learn a greater variety of vocabulary. This course will focus on developing reading, writing, speaking and listening skills. In this course, students will engage in academic activities requiring language, as students develop increasing ease with understanding and using English in a variety of contexts. This class will support student success in all academic areas.

Course Objectives:

- **Speaking:** ELD instruction focuses on English Learners developing the language skills needed to learn content taught in English and to be able to express their content knowledge in English.
- **Reading:** Students will read, analyze, and interpret a variety of literary and informational texts.
- **Writing:** Students will apply knowledge of language for a variety of writing opportunities (summary, justify opinions, etc).
- **Listening:** Students will apply knowledge of language to understand how language functions in different contexts.

Recommended materials needed daily:

- Lined, college ruled, 8.5 x 11 paper
- Agenda or calendar

Google Classroom: In addition to our in class work, we will be using google classroom. We will turn in some of our work via google classroom and some work hard copy in class. Please continue to check google classroom for work and assignments.

Grading Policy:

Grades are earned rather than given. You will succeed in this class through participation, completing your work and putting effort into all assignments.
