


6 Values of The World's Greatest Junior High School

After School


- All students will have ten minutes after school to clear the campus.

- Students waiting to be picked up from school must wait at the front of the school






Mathematics

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
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

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

Connecting with our Campus



Attendance

Canyon Hills Year to Date Average: 96.68%. (Best for JH)

Truant

Absent from school without a valid excuse three full days, or tardy or absent for more than any 30-minute period during the school day without a valid excuse on three occasions in one school year, or any combination thereof

Habitual Truant

Truant on three or more occasions in a school year, provided that a site administrator has made a conscientious effort to hold at least one conference with a parent or guardian and the student, after sending notice

Chronic Truant

Absent from school without a valid excuse for ten percent or more of the school days in one school year, from the date of enrollment to the current date

Dress Code

No undergarments showing

- Pants must be worn at waist
