



May 2025 AP Exam - Test Day Information

NEW! 2025 AP Testing now has 3 formats: DIGITAL, HYBRID, & PAPER.

- Please bring your FULLY CHARGED CHROMEBOOK and CHARGER to your AP exam(s).
- There are very few back up devices available for testing.
- Seniors: Do not turn in your Chromebooks unless you are done with AP testing
- You will use the Bluebook app for most AP exams in 2025.
 - You should all be very familiar with this app from your AP classes.
 - Practice signing in with your College Board username and password.
 - Explore the “Test Preview” questions & take a “Full-Length Practice Exam.”
 - Confirm that you have a virtual TEST CARD for each of your digital exams.
 - You will need to know your log in credentials on exam day.
 - You will not have your phone to be able to “look up” your password.
 - The Bluebook app is not set up to “remember my password.”



5-STAR APP: All students MUST have an ID. You may use the 5-Star app, a physical Ayala ID card, State issued ID, or Driver's License. On test day, you will be checked in at the testing location using the 5-Star app. Download the app to your phone now if you have not done so already.

EXAM LOCATIONS & ARRIVAL TIMES: Check your email in the coming week for your testing location(s). You can also check the Ayala AP webpage for testing locations:

Please plan on arriving at 7:15am for the morning exam and 11:15am for the afternoon exam. If you arrive after the exam has started, you will not be allowed inside the exam room.

NO EARLY DISMISSAL: Students may not be dismissed until the exam has ended. They will be dismissed as a group. It is the student's responsibility to inform their coach or employer of their AP Test obligations, and arrangements should be made accordingly. ATTENDANCE & LUNCH: Parent/Guardians, please complete this form to excuse your student's absence from other classes on exam day. School lunches can also be ordered from this form. The lunches will be available from 11:00am-12:30pm daily during the two weeks of testing. This form must be completed via the parent/guardian email on file in Aeries to be approved.

Students may bring their own snacks/lunch and water in a CLEAR zip lock bag. You will set your snacks on a table near the door to access when you are released for the break. You will not have access to your bag/backpack until you are dismissed from the exam room after the exam is over.

“Help! I Missed My AP Exam!” - If you are absent for your AP exam due to illness or school/sport (CIF)/senior activity conflict, please contact Mrs. Sevillano in the counseling office to change your AP exam to the Late AP Exam

schedule (May 19-23). **If you miss an exam for any reason, a late exam is not automatically ordered.** You must request the late testing exam to be ordered for you. Seniors: Please look at your Senior activity calendar now for any conflicts with your AP exams and inquire about any possible date changes.

CANCELLATIONS: If you decide to cancel your AP exam, you must fill out a cancellation form and return it with your parents' signature. This signed form must be dropped off in the counseling office by 3pm, 2 days before your exam to receive a partial refund. Refunds take 6-8 weeks and are issued by check.

BRING to your exams:

- **FULLY CHARGED CHROMEBOOK and CHARGER (backups are very limited)**
- **Proper ID is REQUIRED (5-Star app, Ayala ID, or Driver's License)**
- You may bring your phone for 5-Star check-in at the door.
 - All cell phones will then need to be TURNED OFF and put inside your bag/backpack or held at the proctor's desk/counter.
 - Any alerts, notifications, alarms, or vibrations from your devices may void the exams of the entire testing room, due to the disturbance it will cause.
- Several No. 2 pencils & erasers. No mechanical pencils, pencil boxes, or pouches.
- 2 Pens with black or dark blue ink for completing areas on the test booklet covers and for free response questions in the paper and hybrid exams.
- **CALCULATORS: Please** make sure you check the list of approved calculators as they will be checked and confiscated if not on the list. There will not be any available to borrow. All exams, except the Statistics exam, have an embedded Desmos calculator for you to use.

- A ruler or straightedge...only if you are taking an AP Physics Test. (Protractors are not allowed.)
- A sweater/jacket, as the testing room may get cold. (No blankets)
- Tissues, chapstick, & feminine products (ok to keep in pockets)
- Food and drinks in a clear zip-lock bag, if available.

DO NOT BRING to your exams:

- Electronic equipment of ANY type, except a phone for check-in. Students caught in the test room with ANY electronic devices after the exam begins will be reported to the Ayala Administration AND College Board.
- Unapproved aids: Books, compasses, styluses, mechanical pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, notes, or colored pencils.
- Rulers, straightedges, and protractors (except as noted above).
- No pencil pouches (use a clear baggie if necessary).
- Paper of any kind. Scratch paper will be provided.
- Computers or calculators (except as noted above).
- Reference guides, keyboard maps, or other typing instructions.
- Watches that beep or have an alarm. Smartwatches. Fitness trackers. Wearable technology.
- Blankets/pillows/stuffed animals
- Earplugs
