2025 Gretchen Hartt McCombs Memorial Music Scholarship

- 1. The scholarship will be awarded to an individual, not to organizations or groups.
- 2. One scholarship will be awarded at a minimum amount of \$1,000 per year.
- 3. Applicant must be a high school graduate or graduating senior, living within the Chino Valley Unified School District boundaries, who is enrolled or planning to enroll in a Community College, State University, or Private College.
- 4. Scholarship recipient must be majoring in or intending to major in music or music education.
- 5. The scholarship is only for educational purposes and proceeds will be sent directly to the school of enrollment.
- 6. Each applicant must complete a signed application.
- 7. Each applicant must submit an original 500-word essay on the value of music education.
- 8. This scholarship is in addition to any others that the Foundation awards in the promotion of the cultural arts to students residing within the Chino Valley Unified School District boundaries.

- 2. Provide two letters of recommendation from adults you respect, who are not related to you, such as a counselor, schoolteacher, music/art/dance teacher, youth leader, or employer.
- 3. List your community involvement such as your school, church, clubs, family, employment, sports, volunteer work, and hobbies. Should be no more than one page (typed, double-spaced, 12 pt. font).
- 4. Complete and submit a W-9 Form along with your Scholarship Application. W-9 form can be downloaded from our website, www.chinoculturalfoundation.org
