




# Philosophies Underpinning Course Outsomes


- Life is close reading
- Revision underscores all learning

- A rhetorical approach to communication is key
- O Successful students develop successful habits
- Effective development in skills is relational
- O Growth in learning involves reflection
- O Engagement & asking the right questions are essential to learning


# My Grading Philosophies

- ✓ Grades should primarily reflect skills, knowledge, achievement (not effort, completion)
- ✓ Focus on standards/outcomes means the most recent assessment is weighted more heavily at grade reporting times
- ✓ Focus on growth, spiraling concepts










## Learning is Trial, Error, & Hard Work





# Understanding Aeries Grades

- 0 = no learning has occurred


