<u>Minutes</u> April 16, 2024

- Welcome & Introductions Dr. Carrizosa started the meeting at 9am with introductions to our department and a review of the agenda.
- DELAC Roles Responsibilities Dr. Carrizosa announced that we have met all DELAC responsibilities set forth by the state.
- Activity Participants were asked to think about things that they have found helpful this year, topics that they need more training on and recommendations for next year. Participants wrote their responses on Post-it notepads and placed them on the charts.
- Annual San Bernardino County Office of the Superintendent Multilingual Recognition -Dr. Carrizosa announced this year's Multilingual Award recipients.
- EL Master Plan Updates DELAC members were shown how to navigate the district website to look up the EL Master Plan. The following topics in the EL master plan were reviewed.
 - Grading of English Learners
 - A-G Requirements Ibis Cordero discussed how to navigate the district website to look at school sites' Career Center information. She also showed the Secondary Curriculum's website for information about high schools. Dr. Carrizosa explained that various college/universities visit the high schools throughout the year to meet with students.
 - Career and College Indicators (CCI)
- Family Engagement/School Connectedness Ibis Cordero discussed the importance of family engagement and emphasized that it is a practice. She also explained how students can feel "connected" to their schools.
- Tips To Support English Language Development at Home Dr. Carrizosa shared a list created by the ELD coaches on how parents can help students over the summer.
- Reviewing California Standards Dr. Carrizosa showed participants on to access the Essential State Standards on the Elementary and Secondary websites for review in preparation of the next school year.
- Survey Results Dr. Finkbiner reviewed staff and DELAC's responses on the LCAP survey. He asked parents to share additional recommendations. The following was shared.

- Goal 2: School Parent Family Engagement and Connectivity
- Lunches: Schools should offer multiple items for main entrées at lunchtime at the elementary level. (Or students don't eat)
- Sharing table- Schools should have a sharing table where students can put the wrapped foods they don't like on a table and other students can pick them up.
- More playground equipment so students are not fighting over limited balls and other equipment.
- Yoga for students.
- After school tutoring programs to help students with ELD
- Consolidated Application for Funding Dr. Finkbiner talked about Title I, II, III, and IV funding and how the money is used. He asked for a DELAC volunteer to add on the application for verification that this information was shared with DELAC. Jay Ho and Carlos Portales volunteered.
- Dr. Finkbiner invited DELAC members to attend the last LCAP meeting on Tuesday May 7th. An invitation will be sent. The meeting ended at 11:05am with a thank you to the parents for participating in DELAC.
