### DRIVER EDUCATION TEACHER

<b>DESCRIPTION OF POSITION:</b>	Provides instruction to secondary pupils to develop the knowledge and attitudes necessary to prepare them for Driver Training.
<b>MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:</b>	<p>Provides instruction and interpretation of the State Vehicle Code.</p> <p>Teaches students the natural laws that apply to driving situations, including adverse conditions.</p> <p>Teaches students the functioning of an automobile, troubleshooting and emergency procedures, and safe driving techniques required for the safe and proper operation of a motor vehicle.</p> <p>Attempts to develop the attitudes of defensive driving necessary for a responsible and mature approach to motor vehicle operation.</p> <p>Attempts to integrate all the knowledges and attitudes that promote reduction of traffic accidents and traffic violations.</p> <p>Conducts testing of students to determine reaction times, vision, depth perception and visual acuity.</p> <p>Keeps necessary records and prepares reports as required.</p> <p>Develops weekly lesson plans and supplementary materials compatible with the basic instructional philosophy and curriculum of the District.</p> <p>Provides students with the opportunity to partake in daily patriotic observance. Education Code 52720.</p> <p>Monitors classroom environment to ensure clean and safe conditions exist, notifying principal of any unclean or unsafe classroom conditions.</p> <p>Monitors classroom activities making students responsible for putting materials, supplies, tools, etc., safely and neatly away at the end of class session.</p>
<b>CREDENTIAL:</b>	Appropriate California credential to teach driver training.
<b>EXPERIENCE:</b>	Supervised teaching or two years of full-time teaching experience, at least half in the subject area in which the teacher is assigned to function.

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**EDUCATION:** Bachelor's degree with major or minor in designated subject matter including all courses needed to meet credential requirements.

**SUPERVISION:** Responsible to: High School principal with Department Chairperson coordinating program.  
Responsible for: Students in class.
