Locker Room Behavior Guidelines

In order to promote a safe environment for all of our students and staff in the locker room, the following behavior guidelines are expected of all students. Students not following the guidelines will receive progressive discipline. Students with repeated discipline problems will lose their locker room privilege.

Locker Room Behavior Expectations

- 1. Students will enter and exit the locker at the appropriate time.
- 2. No horseplay or loud noise in the locker room (such as running, throwing things, chasing each other, yelling, screaming, loud whistling, slamming lockers, clapping, foul language, etc.)
- 3. Keep your hands to yourself and off other student's belongings.
- 4. No aerosols of any kind including hair spray or body spray
- 5. Physical or verbal bullying will not be tolerated
- 6. If you are not dressing out for class, you should not be in the locker room.

Any student who violates the above expectations will be subject to the following actions:

- 1. Warning will be given to the student and parent will be contacted.
- 2. Referral will be given and an administrative detention will be assigned.
- 3. Referral will be given and administrative suspension will be assigned.
