Course Description:

This is a year course. Each semester covers three chapters. The first semester reviews the present and past tenses introduced in Spanish one and two. Each chapter is introduced with a theme and practical vocabulary that is applied along with the grammar lessons. The second semester introduces the three modes of the subjunctive, amongst other grammar lessons and finishes with the future tense. The course provides students with the opportunity to become familiar with the present past and the future. All facets of the language are practiced and shared in the target language. Students will be asked to read, write, speak, and create skits and presentations throughout the year. Students will also be introduced to cultures of the Spanish speaking world via videos and reading activities. Students will be asked to collaborate for certain tasks.

Please note a chapter can take anywhere from 5-6 weeks so it is very important you do not fall behind with the assignments. It is your responsibility to make up any missing assignments when absent. Please make sure you ask questions when in doubt during class time or office hours.

Test & Quizzes:

Quizzes are taken within the chapter. There are usually about 3-4 for each chapter. Students will know 3-4 days in advance when they will have a quiz. Tests are given at the end of each chapter. Students will know a week in advance. Students will have a final exam at the end of each semester.
